After that we continue to Strasbourg, the capital of the Alsace. Sightseeing tour of the city. Being the base of several European institutions, Strasbourg is also a symbolic capital of Europe. In the afternoon we return to Freiburg. Accommodation at the Central Hotel Freiburg****.

Day 5 / Wednesday Freiburg - Lindau - Füssen

After breakfast we drive to the Black Forest and enjoy a short presentation on the cuckoo clock production. We continue to a small traditional Black Forest farm where we have a cheese tasting and you see the real Black Forest. After that we continue the tour to the small island of Lindau in Lake Constance, which offers spectacular views of the Alps. Depending on weather conditions, we will take the Alpine road from Lindau to Oberstaufen and Immenstadt to our final destination Füssen, the southernmost point on our tour of Romantic Germany. Accommodation at the Best Western Plus Hotel Füssen****.

Day 6 / Thursday Neuschwanstein - Wieskirche - Oberammergau - Linderhof - Füssen

We start the day with a visit to Neuschwanstein Castle, built by Ludwig II, the notorious "Mad King". At midday, we travel to Oberammergau, famous for its Passion Play and lovely crafts. Along the way, we visit the Wieskirche Church and take a brief stop at the Ettal Benedictine Abbey before continuing the tour to visit Linderhof Palace. This is one of the three castles built by King Ludwig II of Bavaria and the only one where the king actually lived for a significant amount of time. Return to Füssen. Accommodation at the Best Western Plus Hotel Füssen****.

Day 7 / Friday Füssen - Munich

In the morning we travel to Munich, the capital of Bavaria. We visit the city's main attractions, concluding the tour at the Marienplatz square with its famous clock tower. Munich, the capital of the state of Bavaria is famous for its Oktoberfest, which is annually celebrated in September. The afternoon is free to explore at your leisure. Today the unfinished Congress Hall, houses the Documentation Center Nazi Party Rally Grounds. Accommodation at the Hotel Park Plaza****.

Day 11 / Tuesday Nuremberg - Würzburg - Frankfurt

In the morning we travel from Nuremberg to Würzburg. Arrival at Würzburg, a pretty town on the banks of the Main. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city. One of the tour highlights is a visit to the Residenz Palace in Würzburg. On the way to Frankfurt we have a brief stop at the Mespelbrunn Castle. Accommodation at the Hotel Mövenpick Frankfurt City****.

Day 5 / Wednesday Geneva - Montreux - Zermatt

Sightseeing tour of Geneva. Visit the beautiful parks along the lake, the cathedral and the European headquarters of the UN. Then you travel to Lausanne and Montreux with its magnificent Chillon Castle. Free time to visit Montreux. In the afternoon you explore the Rodano river valley

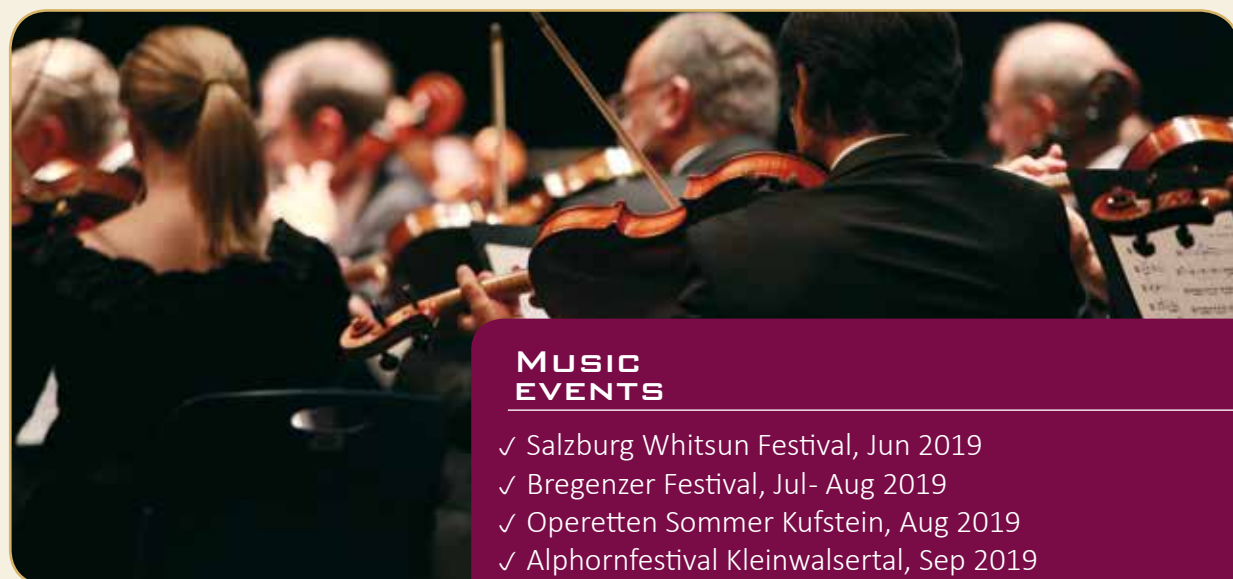

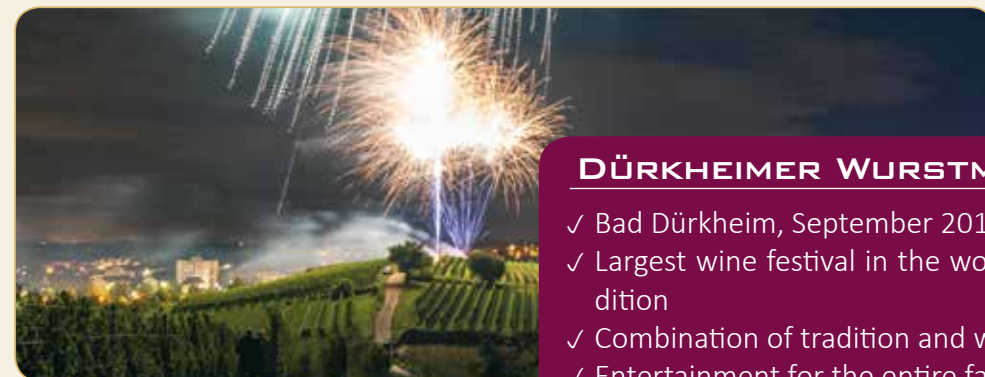

Culinary Germany

Day 1 Frankfurt

After a brief stop at the Ettal Benedictine Abbey we continue to our final destination,

Innsbruck.

Built by "Mad King", Luis II, the castle served as the inspiration to Walt Disney's castle of Sleeping Beauty. Travel back in time and arrive at the castle in a horse-drawn carriage. Then visit the

Wieskirche church, a UNESCO World Heritage monument. The rest of the day is free to explore the small town of Füssen.

Day 5 Füssen - Linderhof - Oberammergau - Munich

After breakfast, travel to the ancient Roman city of Koblenz, one of the oldest cities in Germany. Then continue to the "Deutsches Eck" (the German Corner), where the Moselle meets the Rhine. Cross the river in a panoramic cable car for a spectacular view. On the other side of the river, we visit the Ehrenbreitstein Fort, the second largest fort in Europe. Then continue along the Mo-

selle river and the Ehrbachtal Valley. Ascend to Ehrenburg Castle, where you spend the night.

Day 3 Ehrenburg Castle - Moselle river valley - Trier
In the morning we tour several villages nestled in the Moselle river valley. In Cochem we visit the famous Burg Eltz castle. Enjoy a wine tasting. The next section of the tour will be by boat as you cruise along the Moselle to Bernkastel-Kues, a beautiful and romantic town on the river banks. Today's final destination is the town of Trier, an old Roman settlement with more than 2000 years of history. Enjoy a wine tasting.

Day 4 Trier - Heidelberg

Day 3 Dresden - Meissen - Weimar

In the morning depart for Weimar. Along the way we visit Moritzburg Castle. Nestled in a romantic landscape of lakes and forests, this baroque castle served as the movie set for "Three Wishes for Cinderella". Then continue to Meissen, the first town in Europe to manufacture porcelain. Visit the city's historic center and tour its main attraction: the Meissen porcelain factory. Next we travel to Weimar, the home town of famous historic figures such as Goethe,

Schiller, Bach and Liszt.

Day 4 Weimar - Eisenach - Erfurt - Weimar

Today we travel to Eisenach and explore the impressive castle of Wartburg, where Luther translated the New Testament into German. Then continue to Erfurt, also known as "Thuringian Rome" because of its architectural beauty. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city and visit the Augustine monastery and the Merchants' Bridge (Krämerbrücke). Return to Weimar.

Day 5 Weimar - Leipzig - Berlin

Classic Switzerland

Day 1 Zurich
Upon arrival transfer to your hotel. Visit this extraordinary city that won the award “The city with the Best Quality of Life”, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Zurich and take in the fabulous views of the Alps and Lake Zurich from the Höhenstrasse. Then we continue to Adliswil to take the cable car to Felsenegg, where a great view over Zurich, the lake “Zürichsee” and the Alps’s with its white peaks is waiting for you.

Day 2 Zurich - The Rhine Falls - Lucerne
Today we start the day with a visit to the Rhine Falls, this is Europe’s largest waterfall and it is a grandiose natural phenomenon. Later you have the possibility to do an exciting and unforgettable tour (optional, not incl.) to Jungfrauoch, which is considered “Top of Europe” that has been declared a natural world heritage site by the UNESCO.

Day 6 Interlaken - St. Beatus Caves - Bern
After breakfast travel to Bern. Day 7 Bern - Zurich

Fascinating Switzerland

Day 1 Zurich - Gruyeres - Montreux
Travel from Zurich to Montreux. On the way we stop to visit a local cheese maker in Gruyeres where you learn more about the cheese production. Then visit the Cailler Chocolate Factory with a chocolate tasting. Arrival in Montreux, which is a lovely city located on the shores of Lake Geneva.

Germany and its magnificent cultural heritage (UNESCO)

Day 1 Frankfurt - Romantic Rhine - Cologne

Travel to Rüdesheim and visit the city. Embark on a boat for a tour along the most beautiful and famous stretch of the Rhine: the Lorelei valley, a UNESCO World

Heritage Site. Then continue to Cologne for a sightseeing tour of the city and a visit to the most famous cathedral in Germany.

Day 2 Cologne - Essen - Münster

Day 5 Hamburg - Lübeck - Schwerin

Travel from Hamburg to Lübeck. This city with its lovely old houses was once one of the most important centers of the Hanseatic League and was declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1987. Continue to Schwerin, famous for its castle that stands on an island in the center of town.

Day 6 Schwerin - Berlin

Visit the Schwerin Castle and then continue to Berlin, the capital of Germany. A divided city during the Cold War, Berlin is now one of the most important cultural centers in Europe and boasts exquisite museums, such as the Pergamon, and fascinating architecture, such as the Potsdam Square.

Day 7 Berlin

In the morning visit some of the many attractions of Berlin, including the Brandenburg Gate, the Island of Museums (a UNESCO Site) and the German Parliament building. In the afternoon enjoy a pleasant river cruise on the Spree (approx. 1 hour) and some free time.

Day 8 Berlin - Potsdam - Weimar

Visit Potsdam and the Sanssouci Palace (UNESCO). The former residence of the Prussian kings is a lovely city filled with palaces and gardens. Next we travel to Weimar, the home town of famous personalities such as Goethe, Schiller, Bach and Liszt.

Day 9 Weimar - Bamberg

Sightseeing tour of Weimar. The cradle of the Bauhaus movement and the 1999 European Cultural Capital, Weimar features an amazing collection of classic architecture. In the afternoon continue to Bamberg, located in northern Bavaria. The town is famous for its beer and features a lovely old city center (UNESCO).

Day 10 Bamberg - Nuremberg - Munich

In the morning we briefly pass through Nuremberg, a metropolis that has preserved much of its medieval charm. Our final destination today is Munich, the capital of the state of Bavaria. Munich is known around the world for its Oktoberfest, the largest beer festival in the world, the Bayern München football team and the BMW cars that are manufactured here.

Mozart's birthplace, Salzburg / Austria

Great Composers Bach, Wagner & Händel

Day 1 Berlin

Arrival in Berlin. Discover the German Capital that seduces its visitors due to its rich cultural life. Berlin is home to three very famous international opera houses, depending on your travel date you are able to attend a performance today.

Day 2 Berlin - Leipzig

After breakfast travel to Leipzig. Visit the birthplace of Richard Wagner, the statue of J.S. Bach and the St. Thomas church, where Bach worked as a music director and where Wagner was baptized. At night you attend a concert at the famous concert hall Gewandhaus or at the St. Thomas Church, home to the world-renowned St. Thomas Boys Choir, a choir rich in tradition and committed to continue Bach's musical legacy.

Day 3 Leipzig - Dresden

The tour continues today with a visit to the Bach Museum in Leipzig. The museum presents the life and works of Johann Sebastian Bach and his family in an interactive multimedia exhibition. One of the highlights is the treasure room, where original Bach manuscripts and other precious items are on display. Afterwards travel to Dresden. It is highly recommended to visit the Dresden Frauenkirche, an outstanding

example of Protestant sacred architecture featuring one of the largest domes in Europe, and symbol of reconciliation between former warring enemies. It is also home to many world-renowned classical concerts.

Day 4 Dresden

Both Richard Wagner and J.S. Bach left their marks in Dresden. During a guided tour you see Dresden through musical eyes, learning more about the life of these great German composers. The afternoon's focus lies on the renowned Semper Opera House. You learn more about the past and present of this impressing opera house, where according to your travel date you can also attend to an evening opera performance.

Day 5 Dresden - Bayreuth

After breakfast you travel to Bayreuth. This city is closely related to Richard Wagner. Visit of the "Bayreuther Festspielhaus", the specially designed theater that is world-famous for its annual Bayreuth Festival, at which performances of Wagner operas are presented.

Day 6 Bayreuth - Weimar - Eisenach

On your way to Eisenach you stop in Weimar, where Bach used to work as a court musi-

cian. Upon arrival in Eisenach, you visit the Wartburg Castle, famous for the Tale of the Wartburg Song Contest on which the "Tannhäuser" opera by Richard Wagner is based.

Day 7 Eisenach - Halle - Berlin

In the morning you visit the Bachhaus, a museum dedicated to the life of J.S. Bach who was born in Eisenach, and other important places in the life of Bach. Afterwards return to Berlin. On the way stop at Halle, the city of the baroque composer Georg Friedrich Händel.

Great Composers Mozart & Haydn

Day 1 Salzburg

Arrival in Salzburg, birthplace of the composer Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. Visit the city in the footsteps of Mozart - the monuments and the birth house of the genius of music. Continue with the funicular to the fortress of Salzburg to enjoy the special atmosphere during a dinner and Mozart's concert, above the roofs of Salzburg.

Day 2 Salzburg - Linz - Melk - Vienna

After breakfast, trip to the St. Florian monastery with the famous organ „Brucknerorgel“ near Linz. We continue to Melk to visit the Benedictine Abbey of Melk, the most representative baroque monument of Austria. Trip to Vienna, the capital of Austria and known by the composers Mozart and Haydn. At night, you can attend a concert in the famous castle Schönbrunn (not included).

Day 3 Vienna

In the morning panoramic view of the city of Vienna. You can admire the Opera, the Hofburg Palace, the Heroes' Gate, the Parliament and the Town Hall. On this city tour, Mozart's and Haydn's life in Vienna is the central theme. During his 10 years in Vienna, Mozart reached his most outstanding creative

aspects. Haydn lived 12 years in Vienna and composed much of his „old works“. We visit the Mozart and Haydn house.

Day 4 Vienna - Hainburg - Rohrau - Eisenstadt - Vienna

Travel to Hainburg, the place where Joseph Haydn went to elementary school and got his first music lessons. Visit the exhibition about the childhood and youth of Joseph Haydn. (Visit from June to December possible). Continue to Rohrau and visit Haydn's birthplace. In the afternoon, trip to Eisenstadt, where Joseph Haydn lived for many years as an orchestra conductor of the Esterházy family, creating most of his works. The walk in Eisenstadt takes you to the House of Haydn, the mountain church, the Franciscan church in the old town, with the baroque houses of the city, the town hall and the plague column.

Day 5 Vienna - Brno - Prague

After breakfast, trip to Brno, the little sister of Prague. The metropolis of Moravia, is the second largest city of the Czech Republic. We continue to Prague, the so-called city of a hundred towers. Mozart spent his most successful years of life here. Possibility of attending a concert at Villa Bertramka (not included).

Day 6 Prague

In the morning enjoy a stroll through the historic city center where Mozart and his life in Prague will be in the foreground. Visit of the Powder Tower and the Old Square, which dominates the Town Hall with its Astronomical Clock, the impressive Church of Tyn and the Church of St. Nicholas. We pass the Charles' Bridge, a gallery of Baroque statues with beautiful views of Prague Castle. During the tour through the city you can understand why Mozart dedicated a whole symphony to this city.

History: World War II in Germany and Poland



Package I: From Munich to Berlin

Day 1 Munich
In the morning visit the city of Munich and its most important monuments like the Cathedral of the Virgin and the Marienplatz. You learn more about the birthplace of the Nazi Party and where Hitler fought his way to power. See buildings and memorials connected with the Nazi Party: the Königsplatz where the Nazi Party's mass rallies were held, Hofbräuhaus

where they held their speeches for propaganda, Jakobsplatz, the Feldherrnhalle and the Documentation Center.

Day 2 Munich - Berchtesgaden - Munich
Travel to Berchtesgaden and explore this beautiful, traditional Bavarian village. You visit the "Eagle's Nest", which was built as a present for Hitler's 50th birthday. The region of Berchtesgaden later served as an important strategic objective for the Allied forces in World War II.

Day 3 Munich - Dachau - Nuremberg
After a short drive to the pleasant and beautiful city of Dachau, you arrive at the former Nazi concentration camp of Dachau. Visit the memorial in honor of the Nazi victims. This site teaches us more about the daily lives of the victims during the period of the holocaust. Continue to Nuremberg.

Day 4 Nuremberg
Explore Nuremberg to relive world history with a visit to

Courtroom 600 where the Nazi trials were held. Afterwards you follow the history and visit the Documentation Center, the striking museum at the site of the former Nazi Party Rally Grounds. The remains of buildings and the permanent exhibition „Fascination and Terror“ outline causes, context and the consequences of the regime of terror.

Day 5 Nuremberg - Berlin
After breakfast travel to Berlin. The rest of the day is free at your leisure.

Day 6 Berlin
Visit numerous landmarks, dubious monuments and colossal buildings that stand as stone witnesses to the disastrous dictatorship of terror. Pass by the Wilhelmstrasse and Vossstrasse, the former center of power, the Reichskanzlei, the Holocaust monument and the monument to the murdered European Jews and the exhibition of the „Topography of Terror“.

Day 7 Berlin
Today visit of the House of the Wannsee Conference that was used from 1941 to 1945 by the SS as a conference center and guest house. You also see the Cecilienhof Palace where the summit meeting of World War II's victorious powers took place. The Potsdam Conference stands as a symbol of the end of World War II and the beginning of the Cold War. In the afternoon end of the tour or continue with package II.

Package II: From Berlin to Warsaw

Day 1 Berlin - Terezin - Prague
Today continue to Terezin and see the former Theresienstadt concentration camp. This tragic and dark place reminds about the history and horrors of a Jewish Ghetto where tens of thousands of innocent people had to die.

Day 2 Prague
After breakfast visit the "City of Gold" and hear about Jewish History and visit sites connected to Reinhard Heydrich, the Deputy Reich Protector of Bohemia and Moravia. Visit the only Jewish municipal area in Central Europe which survived the Holocaust. Walk through the Old Town Cemetery and through Maisel Street to the Old Town Square.

Day 3 Prague - Walbrzych - Wrocław
Enroute to Wrocław stop in Walbrzych, located in the Owl Mountains of southwestern Poland, a place where the Nazis built one of the largest military enterprises during the World War II. The secret project Riese (Giant Complex) consisted of numerous underground tunnels and shelters. Continue to Wrocław, once the German city of Breslau that was home to a large Jewish population.

Day 4 Wrocław - Auschwitz-Birkenau - Krakow
Continue to Auschwitz-Birkenau, a former concentration camp that became a symbol of terror, genocide and the Holocaust, all over the world. Like other parts of Poland, Auschwitz was occupied by the Germans during World War II. In 1940 the Nazis established the largest of the German concentration camps here.

Day 5 Krakow and Oskar Schindler's List
Today you visit the Emalia Enamel Factory that was run by Oskar Schindler in Krakow. Learn more about the incredible story of the man who worked on and on to save as many Jews as he could. In the afternoon you hear more about Krakow with its monuments and complex history, visit the site of the Krakow Ghetto and the Heroes Square.

Day 6 Krakow - Warsaw
After breakfast travel to Warsaw. Upon arrival enjoy a panoramic city tour of Warsaw, the capital city of Poland. During the tour you see the most important places in the city.

Day 7 Warsaw

In the Footsteps of Martin Luther

Day 1 Berlin

Welcome and transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore the city at your leisure.

Day 2 Berlin - Wittenberg

The trip begins with a city tour of Berlin. Visit attractions like the Brandenburg Gate, the cathedral of Berlin, the German Parliament building and the lovely boulevards. Then we travel to the city of Wittenberg, where we visit the house of Martin Luther that has been transformed into the most important museum of the Reformation. Next, we visit the Luther's tomb in the Schlosskirche church. We also stop by the St. Mary church.

Day 3 Wittenberg - Torgau - Leipzig

The tour continues to Torgau, traveling through the landscape along the Elbe River. In Torgau,

visit the Hartenfels Palace and its chapel, the first Reformation church consecrated by Luther. We also visit the grave of Katharina von Bora, Luther's wife. We pause in front of the building where the main ideas in the articles of Torgau were developed. In the afternoon, we arrive in Leipzig, the site of the famous debate between Johann Eck and Martin Luther. Sightseeing tour of Leipzig and visit to the Thomaskirche church. We also see the city hall and the St. Nikolai church, where the prayers for peace against the communist dictatorship began.

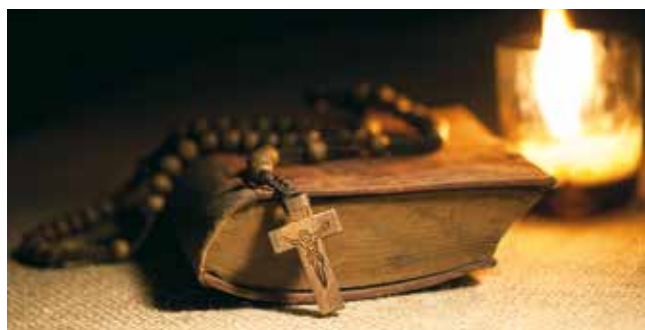
Day 4 Leipzig - Eisleben - Erfurt

After breakfast we travel to Eisleben, "the City of Martin Luther" and UNESCO World Heritage Monument. In Eisleben we visit the house where Luther was born and where he died.

Other attractions on our itinerary include the church of St. Peter and St. Paul, where he was baptized, as well as the church of St. Andrews, where he held his final sermon. In the afternoon we continue to Erfurt, where Luther became a monk. We also have the opportunity to visit the Augustine Monastery, Martin Luther's religious community.

Day 5 Erfurt - Eisenach - Frankfurt

In the morning there is time for sightseeing in Erfurt. Attractions include the St. Mary church and Krämerbrücke bridge. The tour continues to Eisenach. Take a guided tour of the impressive Wartburg Castle, where Luther translated the New Testament into German. Visit the Latin school and Bach Museum, a UNESCO World Heritage Monument. The tour concludes in Frankfurt.



Religious Reform in Switzerland

Day 1 Zurich

After breakfast visit the lovely town of Zurich. This tour includes sights like the Old Town, Zwingli Statue and the Grossmünster Church. Huldrych Zwingli led the Protestant Reformation from Zurich in the 1520's and his pastoral office was located at the Grossmünster Church, a Romanesque-style Protestant church. Rest of the day free at your leisure.

Day 2 Zurich - Basel - Bern

Today we travel to the "cultural city of Switzerland", Basel. Enjoy a short visit of the city that is located on the Rhine River where the Swiss, French and German borders clash. In 1534 Calvin was induced to leave his home and to seek safety in free Switzerland. Here Calvin published his "Christian religious doctrine". Our last destination for

today is Bern, the capital city of Switzerland.

Day 3 Bern - Lausanne - Geneva

In the morning we enjoy a sightseeing tour of Bern, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Reformation in Bern was prepared in the city and throughout the canton by three ministers Sebastian Meyer, Bertold Haller and Francis Kolb and by a gifted layman Nicolaus Manuel, who were all friends of Zwingli. On the way to Geneva short stop in Lausanne, where the pastor Pierre Viret, known as "the angel of the reformation" established a Reformed Academy.

Day 4 Geneva

In the morning we enjoy a panoramic tour of Geneva. First we visit St. Pierre's Cathedral that belongs to the Swiss Reformed Church now. After visit

of the Reformation Monument that honors many of the main individuals, events and documents of the Protestant Reformation. Learn about several reformers that were active here, like Knox, Farel and Calvin, who was the most prominent and influential one and inspired the translation that was to become the Geneva Bible.

Day 5 Geneva - Montreux - Zurich

On the way to Zurich we make a short stop in Montreux, located at the foot of the Alps at the eastern end of Lake Geneva. Montreux boasts one of the most beautiful walks along the lake, stretching from Villeneuve all the way towards Vevey.

Erfurt / Germany

The Roots of Reformation



Day 1 Berlin - Wittenberg

We start the day with a city tour of Berlin. We see the famous Brandenburg Gate, the Cathedral, the Reichstag building and the lovely boulevards. Then proceed to Wittenberg.

Day 2 Wittenberg - Torgau - Leipzig

We proceed to Wittenberg, designated as "Lutherstadt" ("Luther Town"). It was here that Luther gained notoriety by posting his 95 theses to the door of the Castle Church, sparking the movement that would

become the Reformation. In Torgau we visit the sites associated with Katharina Von Bora, including her grave in St. Mary's Church.

Day 3 Leipzig - Eisleben - Erfurt

In the morning you visit Leipzig and the Thomaskirche, where J.S. Bach served as choirmaster for 25 years and where Luther preached and introduced his ideas for the reformation to the people. Upon arrival in Eisleben you enjoy a city tour that includes the houses where Luther

was born in 1483, and where he died in 1546.

Day 4 Erfurt - Eisenach - Schmalkalden - Erfurt

In the morning we start our excursion to Eisenach. Enjoy a guided tour of Wartburg Castle where Luther translated the Bible. You also visit the Luther and Bach Memorials and the Luther House, where he lived during grammar school. On the way back to Erfurt, brief visit of Schmalkalden - founding city of the Schmalkaldic League.

Day 5 Erfurt - Coburg - Würzburg

In the morning enjoy a sight-seeing tour of Erfurt including St. Mary's Cathedral where Luther was ordained as priest. Visit the Augustinian Monastery where Luther lived as a monk and admire the Krämerbrücke. Then we continue to the medieval city of Coburg where we visit the famous Veste Coburg, the fortress where Luther took refuge and lived during the Augsburg Confession. Our last destination for today is Würzburg.

Day 6 Würzburg - Rothenburg ob der Tauber - Heidelberg

During the morning we visit the ancient town of Würzburg, known as "the jewel of the Main River", considered one of Germany's loveliest towns. One of the highlights of your trip will be today's visit to Rothenburg, the best preserved medieval town in all of Europe. During this walking tour you visit St. Jacob's Church with the renowned Blood Altar. Then continue to Heidelberg.

Day 7 Heidelberg - Strasbourg

In the morning we visit Heidelberg, it is the very symbol of German Romanticism and home to Germany's oldest University, where Martin Luther held one of his earliest debates with church leaders. Visit the famous Heidelberg Castle and tour the historic city center. During the afternoon we travel to the City of Strasbourg.

Day 8 Strasbourg - Speyer - Worms

This morning enjoy a panoramic and walking tour of this historic city of Strasbourg and visit Notre Dame Cathedral, that in 1524 was assigned to the Protestant faith by the City Council. See Petite France and the old city with its backdrop of picturesque canals and take 45 minute scenic boat ride which provides a unique view of the heart of this beautiful city as it navigates some of the canals. In the afternoon we leave for Speyer. The city has a compact historic center that is dominated by the Speyer Cathedral, several churches and the Old Town Gate. The cathedral houses the tombs of eight German emperors and kings.

Day 9 Worms - Mainz - Frankfurt

Today we enjoy a brief walking tour in Worms to see the site of the Worms Debates (Diet of Worms), the Reformation Monument, St. Peters, and the Church of the Holy Trinity. We continue to Mainz, where we visit the city and the Gutenberg Museum. You also see its most prized exhibit, the world-famous Gutenberg Bible, the first major book printed in the West using movable type. Also in the heart of Mainz you see St. Martin's Cathedral considered the high point of Romanesque cathedral architecture in Germany. The trip ends in Frankfurt.
